

Online MDIST English Test description

Before the Online Test

Upon timely registration and payment, the candidate shall receive his/her personal Online Exam schedule – link to a Zoom session for one of the scheduled Online MDIST English Test dates: June 15-16, 2020, along with other details and instructions by email.

On the day of the Online Test

The candidate must be present at least 20 minutes before the scheduled start of the exam – in case of late arrival, the candidate shall not be allowed to sit for the Online Test;

The candidate must ensure their online video and audio presence during the Online Test;

The candidate shall arrange the personal test room setup in a well-lighted, visible area with no virtual background.

Before the Online Test. Instruction for candidates:

1. Switch off your mobile phone(s);
2. No browsing of other websites;
3. No talking or discussion;
4. You can change your answers as long as you do not click on SUBMIT button at the last question;
5. If there is any sign or evidence of attempting to cheat during the examination, the test will be declared null and void.

During the Online Test

The total length of Online MDIST English Test is 60 minutes. The Test carries 2 (two) sections:

1. READING SECTION (30 minutes, 30% of the total mark)

Task type: 1 (one) long passage with 10 MCQs at the end

All MCQ answers are automatically saved within 10 seconds, with the option to submit on the last question.

2. WRITING SECTION (30 minutes, 40% of the total mark)

Task type: 1 (one) essay question, requiring a typed in response of 200 words minimum.

NOTE: Each attempted section has a time limit of 30 minutes. Timer will start the countdown, when the candidate clicks on "Begin" button. Once the timer ends, the paper will be automatically saved and submitted.

After the Online Test

All registered candidates are invited to Online Interview, which will be held within the period from June 17 to June 23, 2020.

Each candidate shall receive his/her personal Online Interview schedule – link to a Zoom session for one of the scheduled Online Interview dates: June 17-23, 2020, along with other details and instructions by email.

The Online Interview lasts for 15 minutes and carries 30% of the total mark):

There are 2 (two) parts in the Online Interview:

PART I

The examiner asks the candidate **ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY** and general university entry questions such as why did you choose MDIS Tashkent?

PART II

DISCUSSION TOPICS - any two topics

(SAMPLE. THE ACTUAL THEMES AND TOPICS MAY VARY)

Problems

- What problems do you come across in your work or life?
- Do you feel that problems are opportunities? Why or why not?
- What was the last problem you solved and how did you do it?

Beauty

- How do you feel about the emphasis that people put on beauty these days?
- Do you think that models portray an unrealistic image of beauty? Why/not?
- Do you think beautiful people have better lives? Why/not?

Science

- Science is dull and boring. Do you agree or disagree?
- Any scientific experiments are dangerous to society. If so, why?
- Science is now playing a more important role in our lives than in the past. Do you agree or disagree?

On the day of the Online Interview:

The candidate must be present at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start of the Interview – in case of late arrival, the candidate shall not be allowed to take the test;

The candidate must ensure their online video and audio presence during the Online Interview;

The candidate shall arrange the personal test room setup in a well-lighted, visible area with no virtual background.

Before the Online Interview. Instruction for the candidate:

1. Switch off your mobile phone(s);
2. No browsing of other websites;
3. No talking or discussion;
4. If there is any sign or evidence of attempting to cheat during the Online Interview, the test will be declared null and void.
